

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO9783) affecting the **1) Tuns Road** from its junction with A47 to its junction with St Andres Lane; and **2) Dunham Road** from its junction with A47 to its junction with Barrows Hole Lane in the PARISH OF NECTON to facilitate National Highways junction widening works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 25<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to 24<sup>th</sup> February 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 153 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Tuns Road, Hale Road, Necton Road, Cook Road, Red Lion Close, School Road, Station Road, Swaffham Road, North Pickenham Road, Whitegate Road, Dunham Road, Necton Road, Station Road, Beeston Road, Station Road (Necton, Holme Hale, North Pickenham, Sporle with Palgrave).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

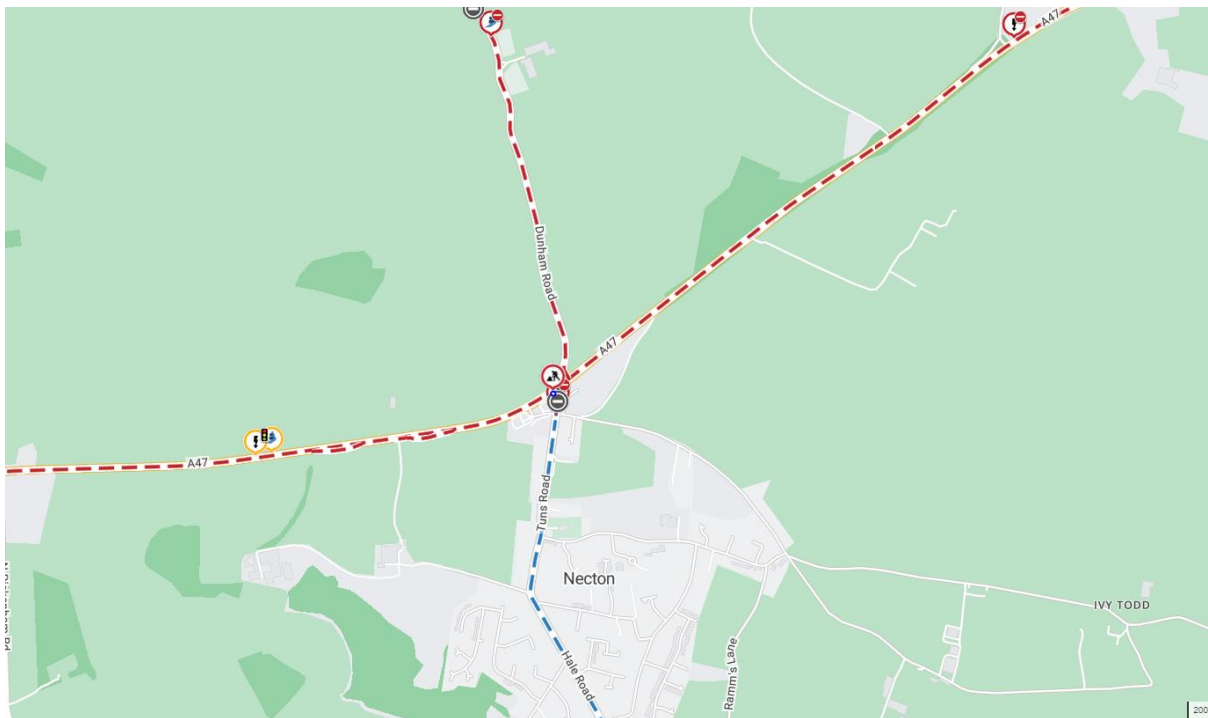
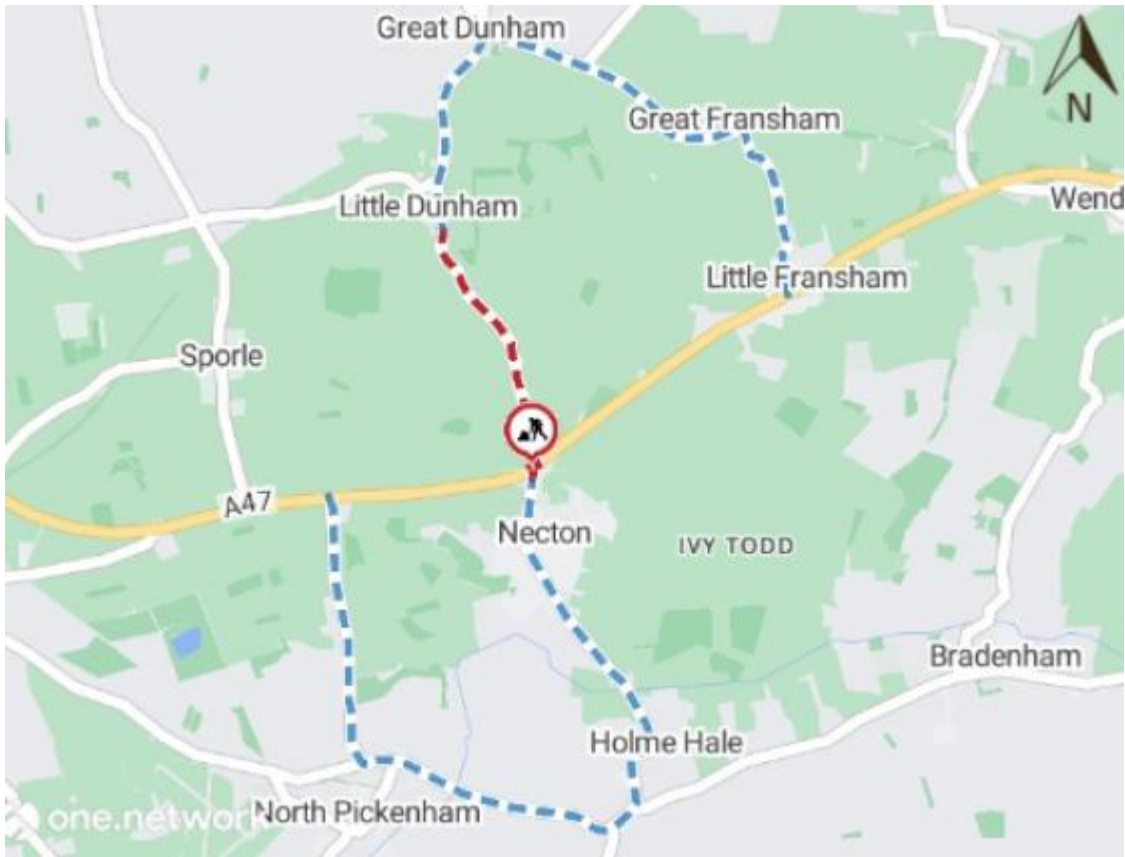
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
